Rodents and Reptiles



As part of our Science Curriculum, we have been given the opportunity for River's Rodents and Reptiles to come to School and do workshops for all classes. Rainbow, Red, Orange, Yellow, Green and Blue children will have the opportunity to handle some animals if they would like to, including a lizard, corn snake, tortoise, guinea pig and a rat. The workshops will be run by a gentleman called River who has devised Ofsted approved lessons for the children to understand habitats, diet and the impact of these animals on the environment. Each session will be an hour long and will enhance the children's learning. It will take place on Thursday 29th and Friday 30th January and the classes will be allocated sessions on either of these days. The cost of the workshops will be £465.00, so we would appreciate a donation of £2.90 per child. Please go to your child's Arbor account and pay through the School Shop section.
